**I.       Approval of June 17, 2019 Regular Council Meeting Minutes and June 19, 2019 Special Council Meeting Minutes.**

**III.     Mr. Bryan Mills, Field Representative for Senator Rand Paul**

Mr. Bryan Mills, Field Representative came before council to announce a luncheon that is being held at the Williamsburg Tourism Center. Mr. Mills invited all Councilmembers to attend the luncheon.

**IV.     Accept deed to parking lot from Williamsburg Housing Authority**

A motion by Councilmember Foley and seconded by Councilmember West to accept the deed from Williamsburg Housing Authority for the parking lot located at corner of 4<sup>th</sup> Street and Sycamore Street in the City of Williamsburg, Ky and authorizing the Mayor to execute said deed to effectuate the transfer of property. All voting aye, motion carried.

**V. Lease Agreement with University of the Cumberland for parking for new apartments.**

A motion by Councilmember Faulkner and seconded by Councilmember Connell to authorize the Mayor to enter into and execute the attached lease agreement with the University of the Cumberlands for that portion of the parking lot that adjoins and runs parallel with Sycamore Street. All voting aye, motion carried.

**VII. Comments**

Mayor Roddy Harrison told council that the city recently had to make flooding repairs to the Briar Creek Bridge, the First Street Bridge, Incline Drive and at Woodlawn Creek. All the projects have been approved to receive FEMA funding to help cover the costs of the repairs. The cost of these four repairs are under \$30,000.00.

Mayor Harrison said the city is also dealing with repairs in the Mt Morgan area, which the repairs are expected to cost in excess \$100,000.

The city also has been dealing with a road repair on a portion of South Second Street that partially collapsed on August 5, 2019. The city originally thought the project was only going to cost about \$11,000, but now it is much more. The city will be applying for Kentucky Transportation Cabinet Emergency Municipal Road Aid funds to help cover those repairs.

Mayor also updated the council on the status of a pothole repair project that has identified 35-40 potholes or small road repairs that need to be done. The repair project will be done in three phases. The first phase of the project is projected to cost about \$11,000 and includes about a dozen potholes or small road repairs. He stated the roads that need repaving will need to be milled first, which involves removing the old blacktop before the new blacktop is laid.

There being no further business a motion to Adjourn was made by Councilmember Harris and seconded by Councilmember Stanfill. All voting aye, motion carried.
