

IV. Accept quote for purchase of ladder truck

A motion by Councilmember Connell and seconded by Councilmember Foley to approve the purchase of a 100-foot aerial platform 1999 Sutphen Custom Fire Apparatus fire truck and upon recommendation of Mayor Harrison the city will finance the ladder truck with Whitaker Bank, at a fixed rate of 3.25 percent for five years. All voting aye, motion carried.

**V. Comments
Mayor Harrison**

Mayor Harrison stated that the city is looking into a fleet replacement plan for all city vehicles, like they did with their police vehicles. The city will sell older vehicles when they have the maximum resale value and before the vehicles start accumulating too much cost in terms of maintenance. Enterprise projects that the city could save about \$400,000 over 10 years with the fleet replacement plan for all of its vehicles.
